# **TEMPERATURE**

The house is primarily heated by baseboard radiant heat. The thermostat outside the kitchen controls the entire main floor, while the thermostat on the second floor controls both the second and third floors. Each bedroom has its own wall-mounted heating and air conditioning unit for added comfort. Additionally, the house is equipped with three AC mini-split units: two located in the main floor living area and one in the third-floor hallway. These units are controlled by remote controls located in their respective areas.



## HUMIDIFIERS

Extra humidifiers are available in the second-floor closet. Park City's climate can be quite dry, particularly during the winter months.

# TRASH

Trash pickup occurs every Friday, and recycling is collected every other Friday. Please ensure that bins are not overfilled, as items will not be collected if the bins are overflowing.

# **S**AUNA

To operate the sauna, set the timer to 1 hour or less. This safety feature ensures the sauna cannot remain on for more than 1 hour without someone manually resetting it in case someone falls asleep. Although the timer can be set for up to 8 hours, the sauna will only activate when the timer reaches the 1-hour mark. For example, if you want the sauna to turn on at 5 PM, you can set the timer to 8 hours at 10 AM.

Iron Canyon Trail

A 2 mile lightly trafficked out and back trail located near Park City, Utah that features a great forest setting and is rated as moderate



Mine Shaft Loop

A 2.8 mile loop trail located near Park City, Utah that features a great forest setting and is good for all skill levels.



# PC Hill Trail

A 1.3 mile moderately trafficked out and back trail that is accessible year-round. Dogs are also able to use this trail but must be kept on leash.



### Armstrong & Spiro Loop Trail

A 6.1 mile heavily trafficked loop trail that offers scenic views and is rated as moderate. The trail is primarily used for hiking, walking, nature trips, and bird watching and is best used from April until September. Dogs are also able to use this trail but must be kept on leash.



Lake Blanche Trail

A 6 mile or 10 mile hike in the Twin Peaks Wilderness Area where you can get views of the opposing quartzite mountains as well as Great Salt Lake. NO DOGS ALLOWED
